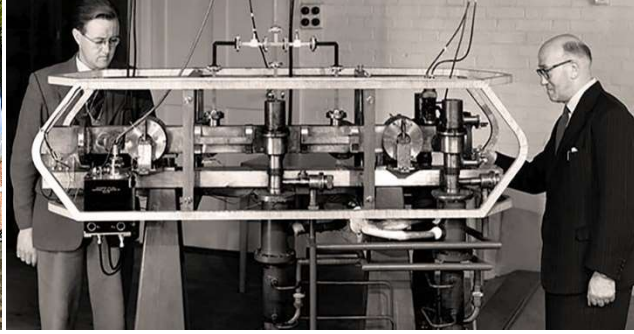

The 20th century brought quartz and atomic clocks, along with the watch industry's transformation through automatic and quartz technology. The 21st century saw further evolution of atomic clocks, the rise of smartwatches, and the enduring legacy of traditional craftsmanship. A double-sided hollow flying tourbillon is a complex watch feature showcasing intricate mechanics and enhanced accuracy. This design allows for a transparent view of the watch's inner workings, creating a mesmerizing display of timekeeping in motion



Antikythera Mechanism

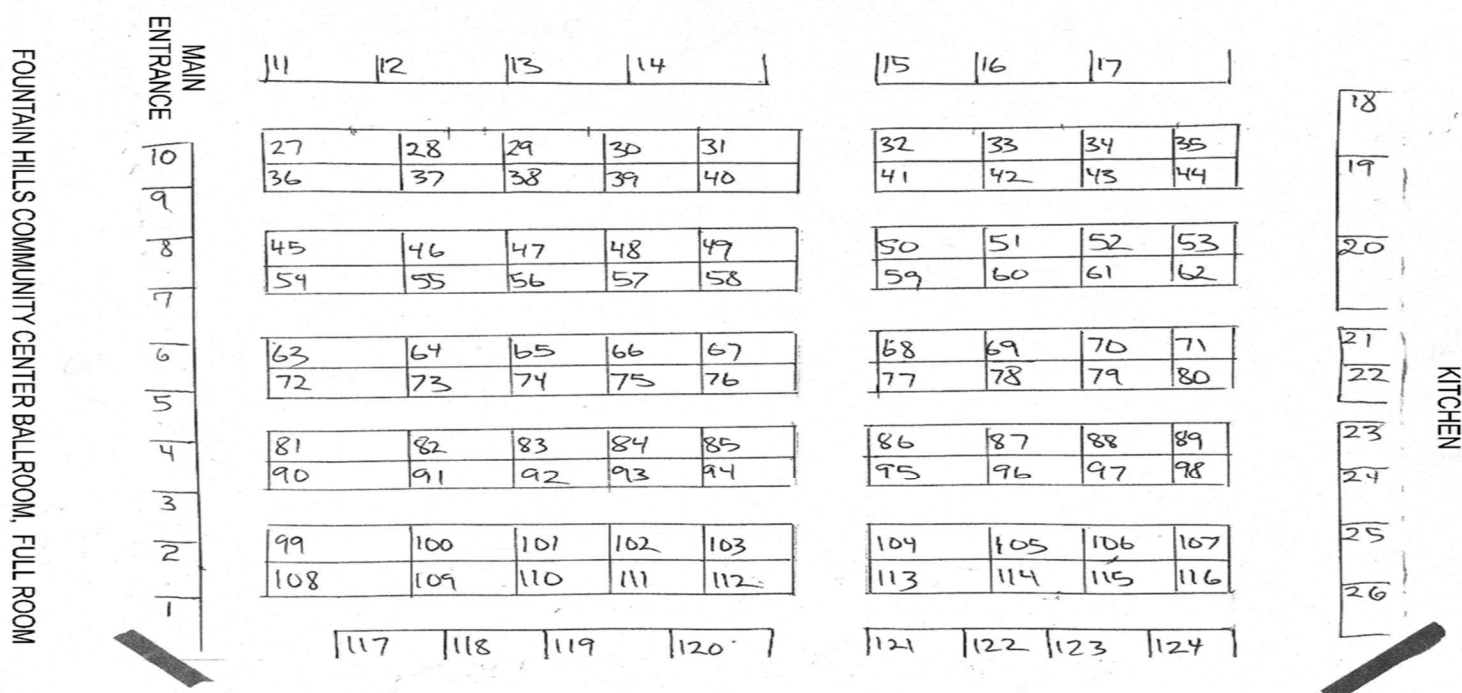
(c. 100 BC) The mechanism consists of a complex system of 30 wheels and plates with inscriptions relating to signs of the zodiac, months, eclipses and Panhellenic games. The study of the fragments suggests that this was a kind of astrolabe. (In the video Room)
